7. CORRESPONDENCE/PROPOSALS/REPORTS

- **a. Annual Brown Act Training:** Dr. Jeffrey Felix facilitated a thorough Brown Act training for the members of the B.E.S.T. Academy Board. The training reviewed standard and new Brown Act guidelines. Dr. Felix explained Senate Bill (SB) 126, which provides charter school transparency to the public. Additionally, Dr. Felix presented the board information about the March 2020 Executive order by Gov. Newsom. At the start of COVID-19. Gov. Newsom issued Executive Order N-29-20 which relaxed guidelines for teleconferencing.
- **b.** Governance Training Charter School Development Center modules at own pace: Mr. Soriano reminded the board on the Governance Training self-paced modules. Each board member should have received an email invitation from the Charter School Development Center (CSDC) to access the training modules. Mr. Soriano discussed the cohesive and helpful training that focuses on charter schools within the modules.

c. ELPAC Testing Window Open: February 1st - May:

- i. Mr. Soriano explained The English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC) as the mandated state test for determining English language proficiency (ELP) proctored by B.E.S.T Academy to the students. The assessments are given to students whose primary language is any language other than English.
- ii. About the ELPAC: The state of California provides practice tests in order to assist the students in understanding the instructions and what is expected of them. The ELPAC includes speaking segments of the assessment in how students respond verbally in English.
- **d. WASC Application and Visit: February 25th** Mr. Soriano explained The Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) accreditation that allows B.E.S.T. Academy courses to be recognized when students are applying to universities. Mr.

Soriano detailed the application and interviewing process for receiving accreditation from WASC. Mr. Crook's leadership in the WASC interview process has been thorough in preparation. Mrs. Stanga added that the process is rigorous and detailed and would benefit B.E.S.T Academy to undergo the WASC review.
